138 Completion

The MRC has commissioned the public relations firm Mercure and the Institut de recherches en économie contemporaine (IRÉC) to produce an analysis of the benefits and necessity of completing Route 138. This document will be attached to the opportunity study drawn up by the Groupe Mobilité Basse-Côte-Nord and presented to the Ministère des Transports et de la Mobilité durable. The objective of this process is to present a more complete picture of the impacts that the completion of Route 138 would have on the development of our region.

CISSSCN – MRCGSL Representation

Considering that the new structure of the CISSS de la Côte-Nord Board of Directors, under Santé Québec, provides for a reduction in the number of seats, the MRC Council of Mayors will propose a joint candidacy with the MRC de Minganie to ensure effective representation of our issues and realities. This proposal will be submitted to the Assemblée des MRC de la Côte-Nord before being presented to the CISSSCN.

Administration (cont.)

Abolition of RénoRégion

The MRC Council of Mayors strongly condemns the abolition of the RénoRégion program, which helped people with modest incomes renovate their homes. Joining the initiative launched by the Fédération québécoise des municipalités, the Council of Mayors hereby calls, by resolution, for the program's return in an improved version.

Economic Development

The MRC du Golfe-du-Saint-Laurent is still awaiting information from the ministère des Affaires municipales et de l'Habitation before being able to relaunch the financial assistance programs tied to **Component 2 of the Regions and Rurality Fund**.

The new terms and conditions of this financial assistance fund will be communicated at a later date.
