Climate Plan

The urban planning agency l'Atelier urbain has been commissioned by the MRC to develop a portion of a first-ever *Climate Plan* for our territory. The document is a planning tool designed to combat climate change at the local level, notably by producing an inventory of greenhouse gas emissions and assessing their reduction potential.

MAMH's Regional Presence

The MRC is concerned about the large number of vacant positions in the regional office of the Ministère des Affaires municipales et de l'Habitation, and the delegation of responsibilities outside the region. This situation raises fears of possible service disruptions and impacts on services rendered to the North Shore population. Golfe-du-Saint-Laurent joins other MRCs on the North Shore in calling on MAMH to remedy the situation.

New CEO at CISSSCN

The MRC is very pleased with the appointment of Jean-François Miron as the new CEO of the CISSS de la Côte-Nord. Mr. Miron took on his new responsibilities on July 7. We hope he will have the opportunity to visit our territory to better understand its particularities, and we wish him every success as head of the CISSSCN.

The MRC supports the municipality of Blanc-Sablon's request to the Ministère des Transports et de la Mobilité durable to implement urgent measures to make a segment of Route 138 safer, following the accident that occurred last June.
