## Administration

### Build Canada Homes

The Golfe-du-Saint-Laurent is joining forces with other communities to ask the new federal entity, Build Canada Homes, to be more flexible in deploying the program across the country to enable projects in rural areas like ours. We are asking the federal government to include a separate component of the program that is managed locally and designed to meet the housing needs of Quebec regions.

### Tourism Tax Credit

Following a request from the business community, the MRCGSL submitted a request to the Ministry of Tourism and the Ministry of Finance to include our region in the tourism tax credit program. The program is notably in effect in the Magdalen Islands and helps entrepreneurs support the growth of their businesses.
