## Administration

### A Day in the Life

The MRC du Golfe-du-Saint-Laurent has submitted a request for financial assistance to the Ministry of Employment and Social Solidarity for its project *A Day in the Life, an Immersive Experience*. The project will allow students aged 16 and over and people who are distant from the labor market to immerse themselves in various jobs available on the Lower North Shore. The initiative aims to reverse the region's demographic situation and help people choose their studies in a way that meets local human resource needs.

### Warden's Code of Ethics

The code of ethics for the warden elected by universal suffrage was adopted by the MRC at the last Council meeting. The implementation of such a code of ethics is a government requirement and allows the MRC to set out the values and principles governing the position of warden. For other elected officials sitting on the MRC Council, the codes of ethics of their respective municipalities apply at all times.

## Administration (cont.)

### La Ruche

La Ruche is a Quebec crowdfunding platform that aims to support social projects led by businesses, organizations, or individuals. To continue expanding its services in eastern Quebec, La Ruche is seeking support from the Côte-Nord MRCs. The MRCGSL has agreed to provide financial assistance totaling \$10,800 over three years.

## Economic Development

Each month, the MRC Council receives requests for financial assistance from local developers. This month, three (23) projects were submitted and approved under the Quebec Social Initiatives Fund (FQIS) for a total of **\$78 153.75** in grants.
