Priorities of the Public Safety Committee

The MRC's Public Safety Committee has adopted its priorities for the coming year: preventing and combating illicit drugs, focusing on community policing (ensuring a visible presence in communities while enforcing traffic laws) and protecting our children and seniors through awareness. The Public Safety Committee is composed of MRC elected officials and a representative from the Sûreté du Québec.

Nearly \$800,000 invested in 2025

In 2025, the MRC provided nearly \$800,000 in funding to support projects by businesses and organizations in the Basse-Côte-Nord region, thereby contributing to the region's economic growth and community well-being. The Signature Innovation program of the Regional and Rural Development Fund provided \$121,255.92 in funding, and the Vitalization program of the Regional and Rural Development Fund provided \$660,215.19 in funding, for a total of \$781,471.11.

Administration (cont.)

Abolition of the Quebec Experience Program

The MRC has joined forces with several other municipal organizations to call on the Quebec government to revise its immigration policies so as to allow temporary residents to complete their immigration process in accordance with the rules in effect at the time of their arrival, and to enable businesses to hire immigrant workers when business needs warrant it.

Various grants are currently available to support projects by local businesses and organizations.
